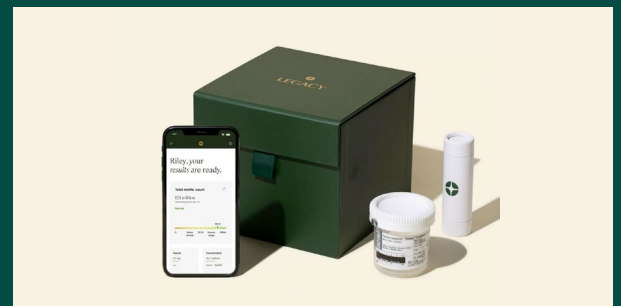

01. Dedicated Care Advocates help members navigate their benefits, create customized care plans, and connect members with resources both on and off Maven.

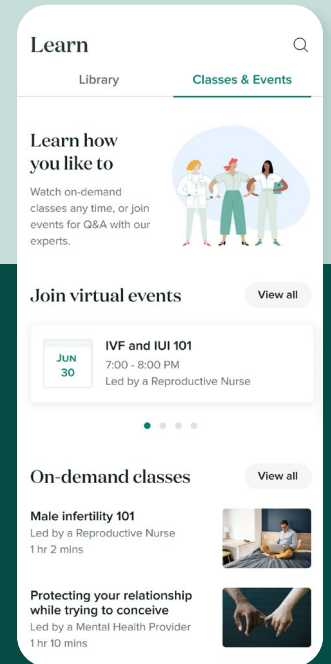
