## **Important Dependent Eligibility Information**

If you are newly enrolling a dependent under your coverage, you will receive a letter from Consova regarding the dependent eligibility verification process.

Consova Corporation is an organization working with Catholic Health to confirm eligibility of the dependents enrolled in our plans. As part of the benefits enrollment process, you will be required to submit the appropriate documentation for each of your enrolled dependents directly to Consova. The form of documentation you need to provide will depend on the dependent's relationship to you. Some examples are listed below

Relationship	Type of Documentation Needed to Verify Eligibility
Spouse	Marriage Certificate; AND
	Federal Tax Return
Biological Child	Birth Certificate showing employee as the parent
Stepchild	Birth Certificate; AND
	Spouse documentation (Marriage Certificate and Federal Tax Return)
Qualifying Relative	Birth Certificate; AND
(grandchild)	Federal Tax Return claiming dependent as a qualifying relative
QMCSO Child	Signed Qualified Medical Child Support Order (QMCSO)
